
De Bos - Elands River

ROCK: Quartzite & sandstone. Main crag is a slab about 12m high about a meter thick. Climbing is on both sides. There are 12 sport lines. Very limited potential for new lines at Main Slab. There is tons of other rock around.

HISTORY: The routes were bolted by Hermie Venter while he was working as a volunteer at De Bos. De Bos is evangelical Christian youth camp.

ACCESS: De Bos is on private property, it is quite difficult to find & to get too. There are at least 5 locked gates between the road & the campsite. Basically you will need to make arrangements to go there & go with somebody who has access. For now access can be arranged via Wynand Nel wynandnel.home@gmail.com

DIRECTIONS: It's off the Elands River road, but it is not easy to get to, basically you will need somebody who knows the way to take you there.

WALK IN: 5 minutes.

Main Slab

From the campsite, walk towards the Elands River. The Main Slab face is a couple of hundred meters out of the campsite. Routes are recorded R to L.


