



Beacon Bay Cave Trail

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Directions: Find Old Transkei Road. Travelling in the Beacon Bay direction, over the Batting Bridge, R into Beaconsur Drive. Park on the L, opposite Beacon Bay Country Club. Find the Cave Trail path.

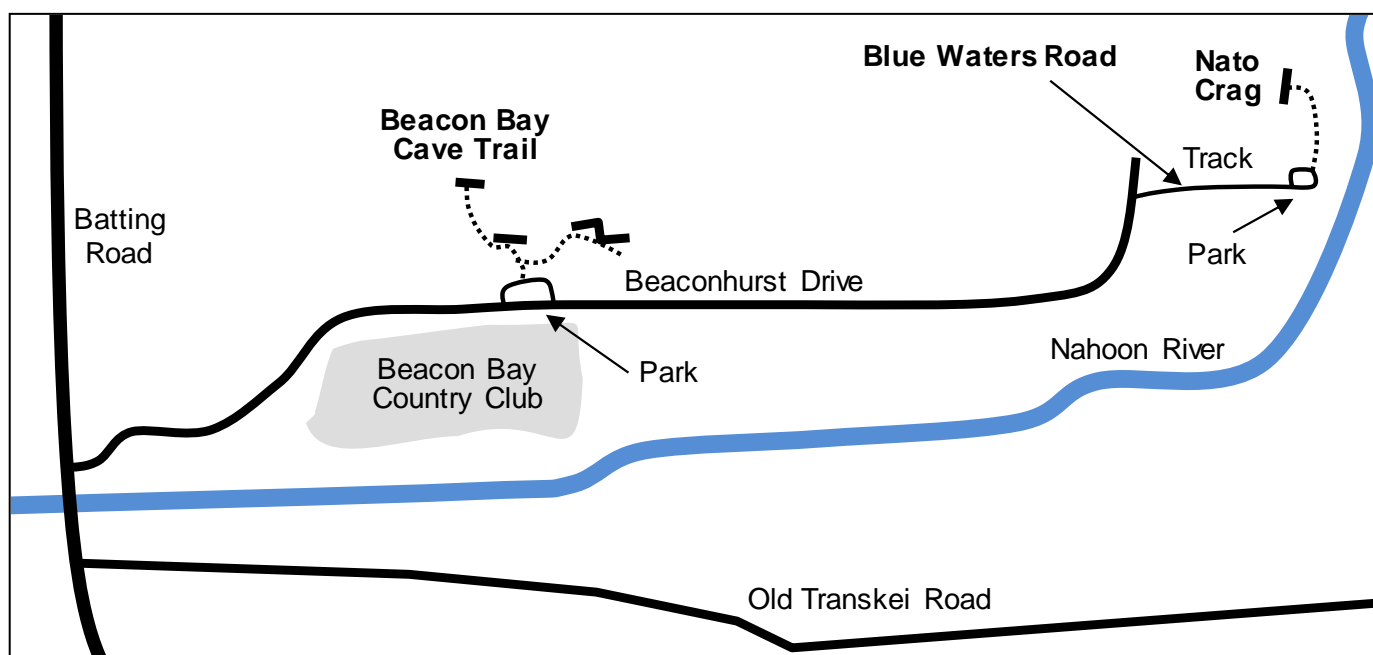
Access: Unrestricted at this stage. Please don't make excessive noise or disturb the local homeowners. The people who own the house closest to the *Cave Trail* think that they own the *Cave Trail* & are quick to let you know that they are attorneys. Don't let them put you off... it's a public nature reserve open to all, actually fuck them!

Walk-in: 1 minute. 80m max. Sort of steep-ish.

Time & Weather: Set in trees, thus all day shade. The sort of spot for a quick climb or bolder mid week or on a busy week end. These bits of rock are actually in the suburbs.

Rock Type: Dolerite set in thick bush.

Potential: There is one more line that could be bolted...too the R of *Industrial Mass Action*. There may be quite a few other lines. It depends how low your standards are. Come on give it a miss! It's not that good at all.



History: Ja...lots of history. Steeped in history! There should be a monument erected to all the happy teenage couples who enjoyed nature in the *Cave*.



Hazards: Maybe wine-ou-s & turds in the bush.

Short off width open book.

5. DCSA Bucks -12

Rails to the R of short off width open book.

These routes are around the corner to the R. Under an overhang.

6. The The – 17

Garvin Jacobs & Derek Marshall Sept 1999 (T)

A line just R of the arête.

7. Undeserving – 15

Derek Marshall & Garvin Jacobs Sept 1999 (T)

Crack system below a large paper bark tree.

8. Tart – 17

Derek Marshall & Kendyl Kunhardt 2001 (T)

Slab to the R of *Undeserving*.

Nato Crag

Situated on the Beacon Bay side of Nahoon River Mouth. See the *Beacon Bay Cave Trail* map above. From Beacons Drive, turn into Blue Waters Road. This becomes a track, which leads to a parking area & Nahoon Mouth Estuary Nature Reserve. Walk in the direction of Nahoon Mouth. Do not climb here! Its just total crap! One route was opened. *NATO Crag* was found by Jochen Gantert, spotted from the pub at the Blue Lagoon Hotel. We should have stayed in the pub! These were the desperate days before *NSA* was discovered. We were ready to climb any thing. The same day Graem opened *NATO Spies*, we drove from here to Horseshoe Valley & discovered *NSA*.
