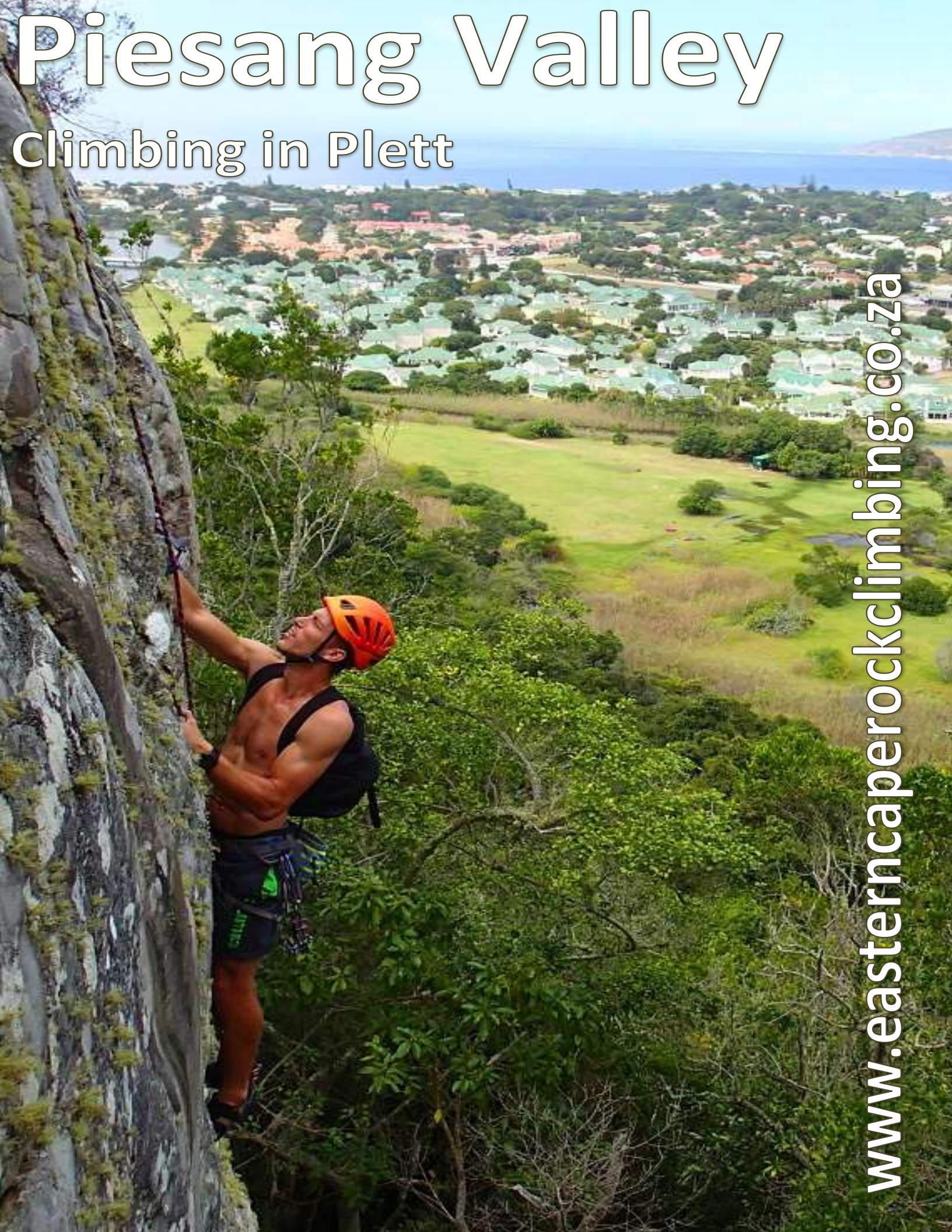

Up the RH perfect cracks to the top of the pinnacle.

Up the front side of the small free stander.

14. Banana Milksnake – 17

Up wide-open book on corner. Directly up.

15. It's a Mad World – 15

Up ramp break, over ledge, up crack, past tree.

16. You're Insane – 16

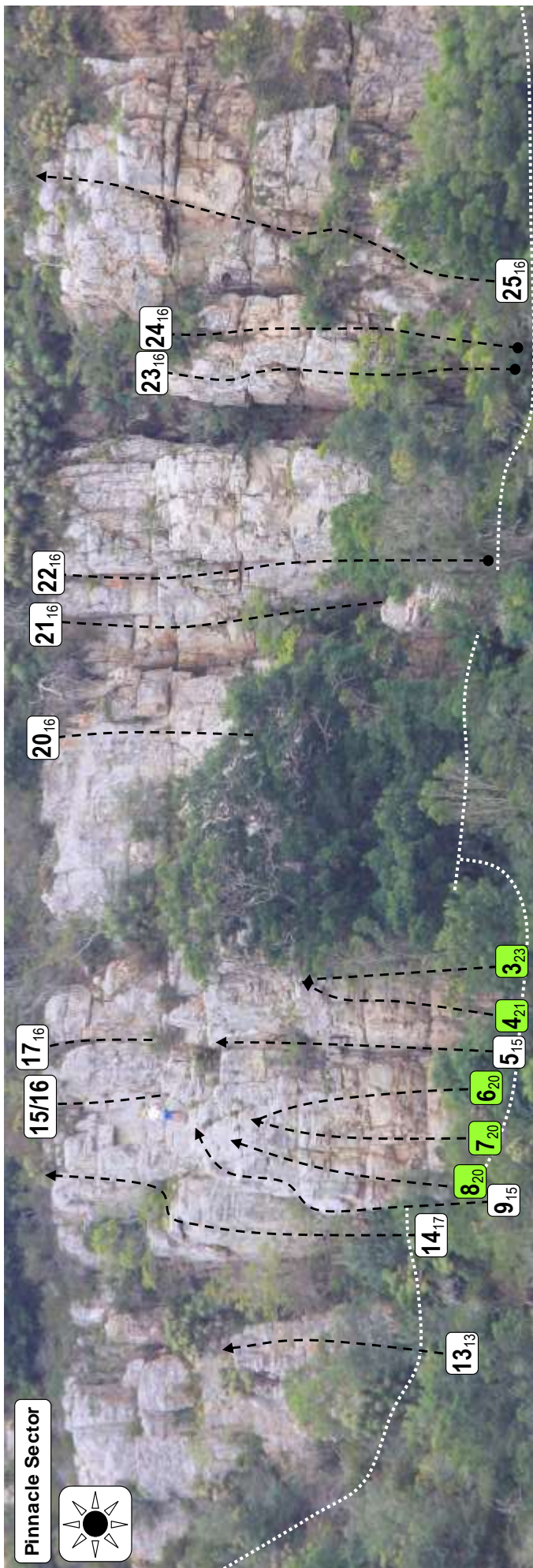

Up steps into crack, up onto ledge. Step L up crack.

17. Countdown – 14

Up ramp crack onto ledge. Up wide crack.





18. Three Six Five – 16

Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 19/05/2019 (T)
Up break in ramp 1.5m L of chimney. Move R to arête of chimney. Directly up.

20. Soft Banana – 16

Dale Gathercole & Danor Groenewald 18/05/2019 (T)
Up bulging ramp crack, over ledge. Directly up.

21. Helix – 16 ★★

Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 18/05/2019 (T)
Up prominent L trending prominent crack.

22. The Score – 16

Terence Trevaskis & Derek Marshall 18/05/2019 (T)
Start 1.5m R of *Helix*. Up juggy break. Step R & then directly up.

23. Search My Dreams – 16 ★

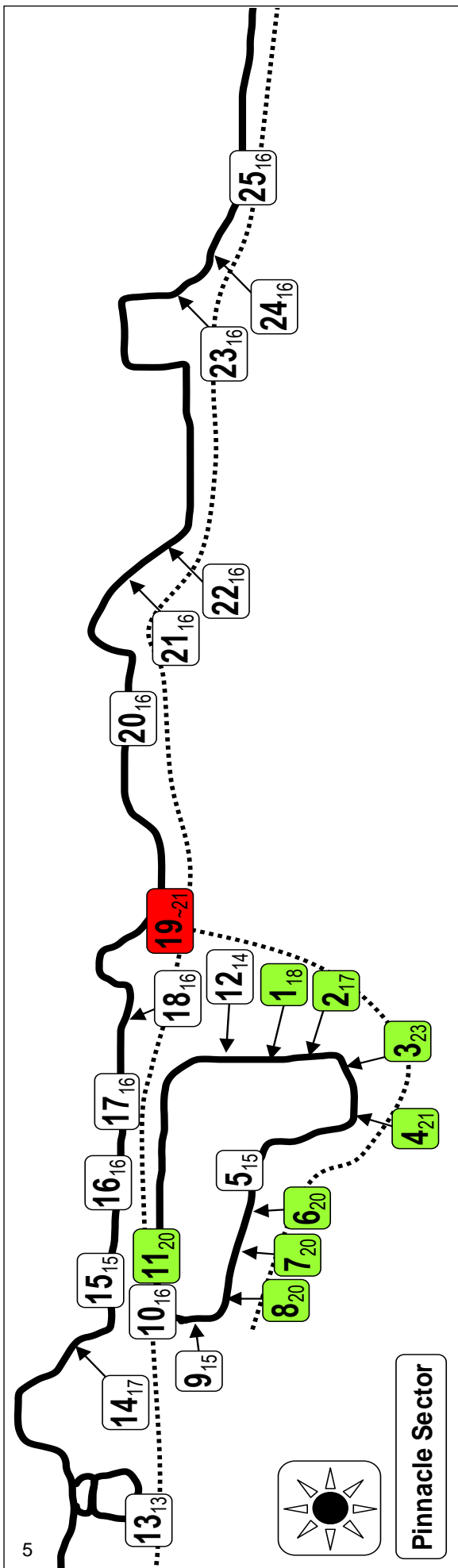
Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 18/05/2019 (T)
Up jugs to R of gully, trend L into brown hollow. Up slightly L.

24. Break Through – 16

Terence Trevaskis & Derek Marshall 18/05/2019 (T)
Up stepped groove 1m R of *Search My Dreams*. Over prominent horn. Directly up.

25. Tysons Delicious Nineteen – 16

Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 19/05/2019 (T)
Up into groove, step R onto ledge & up onto next ledge. Step L on ledge & up open book & into R trending diagonal.

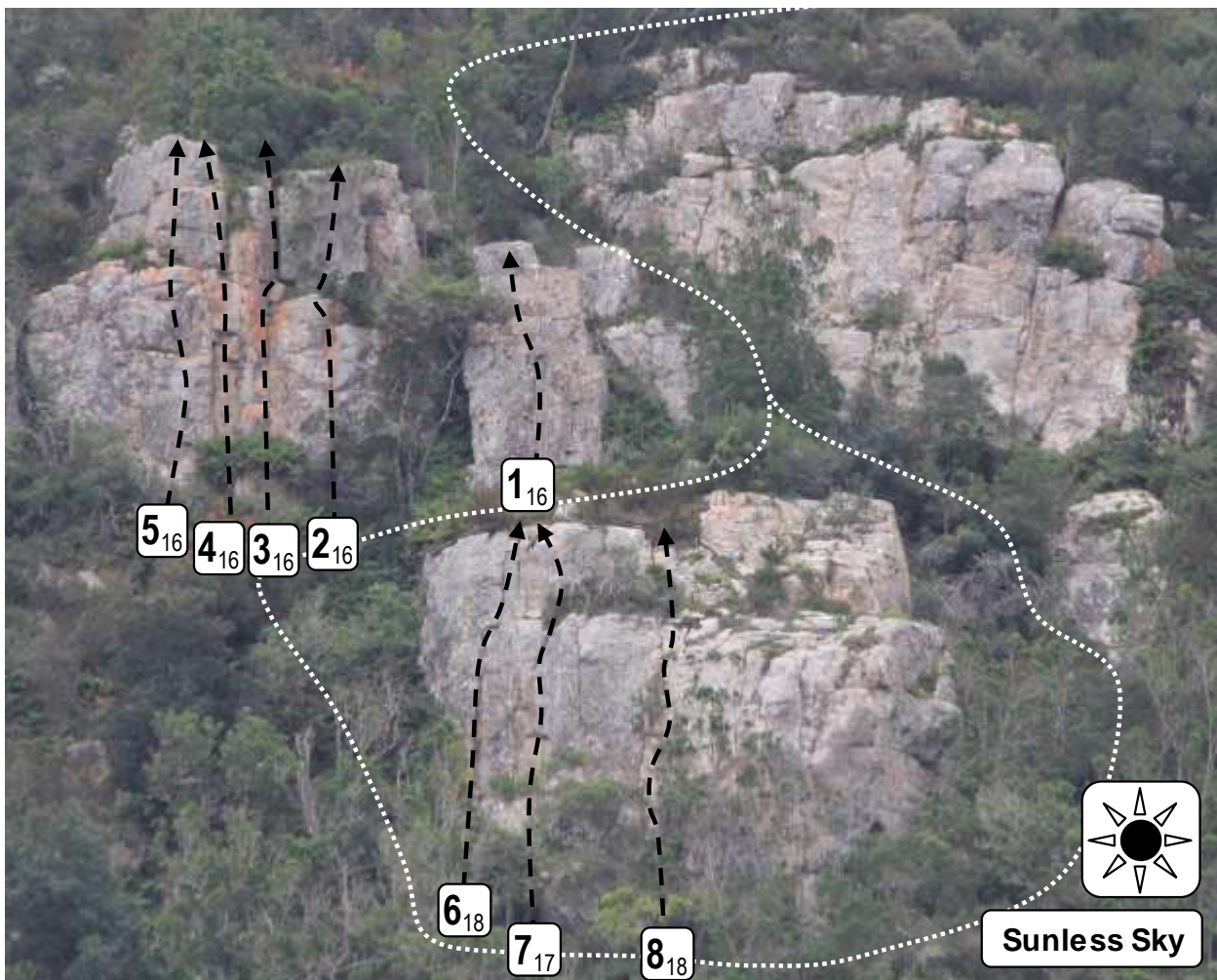


Sunless Sky



These are mostly easy lines, but there is some nasty hard looking sport potential.

- 1. Fallen Prophet – 16** 10m Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 08/03/2015 (T)
Up the curved crack to the top of the free stander.
- 2. Trip the Darkness – 16** 12m Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 08/03/2015 (T)
Up open book break on RH side onto ledge with tree, up arête above.
- 3. Dutt Gooi – 15** 10m Terence Trevaskis & Ruan Grundlingh 08/03/2015 (T)
From ledge, up hand crack open book onto ledge. Up easy open book above.
- 4. The Dragon Lies Bleeding – 16** 13m Terence Trevaskis & Ruan Grundlingh 08/03/2015 (T)
Up crack onto ledge at the base of the open book. Up arête above to top.
- 5. Darkest Hour – 16** 12m Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 08/03/2015 (T)
Up small curved crack to a rail. Rail L, up onto ledge, up small face above.
- 6. Kill the Light – 18** 12m Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 08/03/2015 (T)
Hard start to gain crack system, move R & directly up.
- 7. Stone Cold – 17** 12m Terence Trevaskis & Derek Marshall 08/03/2015 (T)
Up prominent break.
- 8. Unchained – 18 ★** 12m Derek Marshall & Terence Trevaskis 08/03/2015 (T)
Prominent open book.

Park at the viewpoint. Walk about 70m down a good path to the crags.

A. Imploder - 5

Up the arête.

B. The Contrast - 6A

Up the R facing small open book.

C. The Fallen – 6A+

Prominent crack system.

D. Feel the Light – 7A

Crack through overhang, stops at the top of crack.

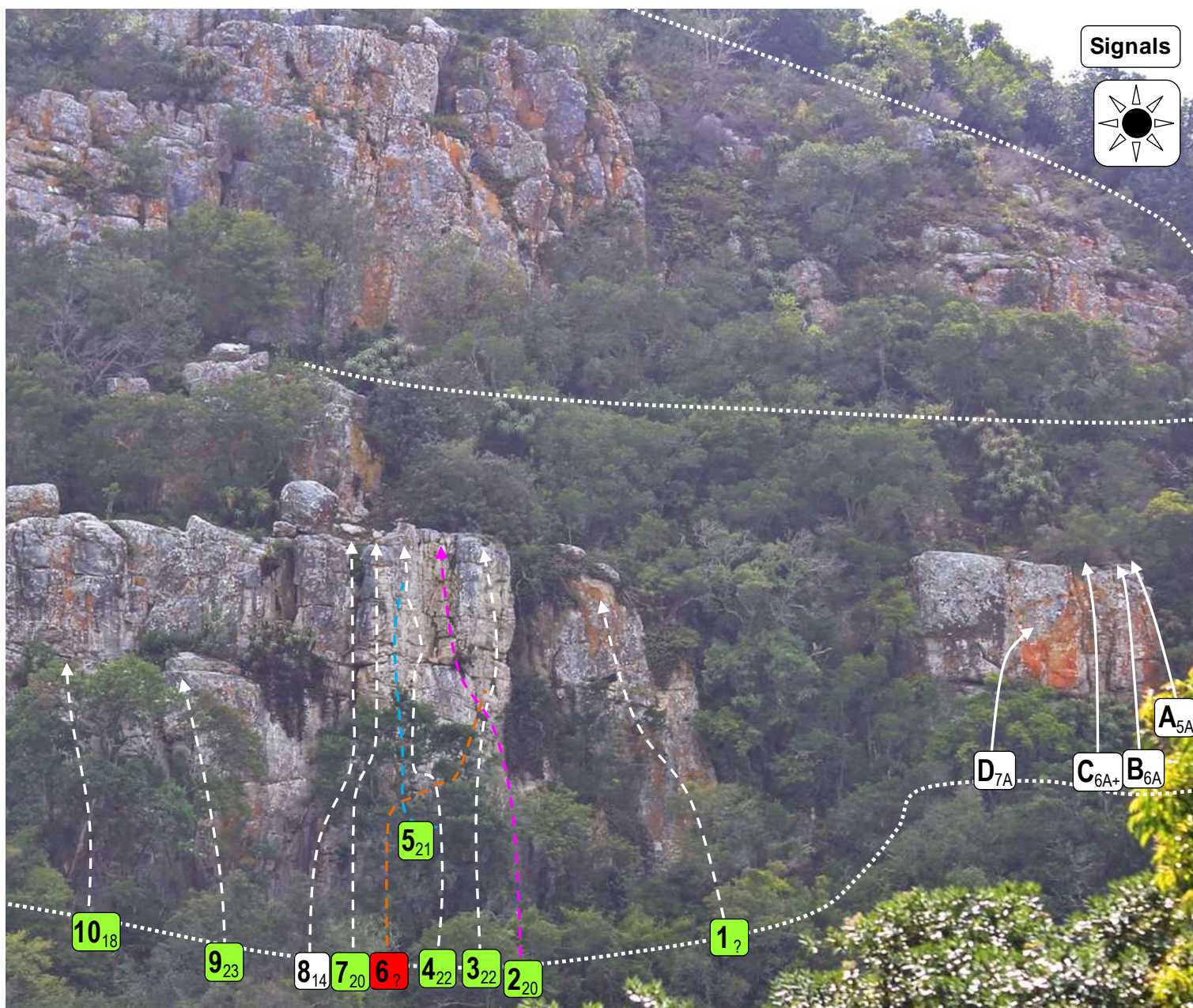
